Academics

_____ We understand and agree with the academic policies and will be responsible in making sure assignments are complete.

Fee Payment

_____ We agree to pay a non-refundable registration fee of 45.00 per semester per family due at time of registration.

_____ We understand and agree that if we withdraw from a paid class after Registration, those fees are non-refundable.

Conduct

_____ We understand and agree to abide by the following rules of conduct:

- Students are expected to complete course assignments on time and come fully prepared for class.
- If a student is absent to 4 classes in one semester, he/she may be asked to drop the class
- If a student is tardy to class 2 times in one semester, a detention will be assigned.
- Inappropriate behavior or a disrespectful attitude may result in dismissal of Co-Op.
- Students who are driving to co-op must have written permission on file. Students will not be allowed to take other students other than siblings off-site without written permission from all parents involved.

Work

_____ We understand and agree that we are required to volunteer hours equal to the number of class hours attended. We will try to give a free hour for parents, but our first priority will be the welfare and needs of students. If I have an infant, toddler, or preschooler, I am required to spend the majority of my time assisting in their classrooms.

Dress Code

_____ We have reviewed a copy of the Revised Dress Code Policy (2007-2008) and we fully understand the policy and agree to abide by it:

Parents (PLEASE)

- Make yourself aware if child/ren has been given assignments
- Supervise the study of additional materials through the week
- Be ready to drill material scheduled by the teacher
- Oversee the completion of assignments
- Prompt your child/ren to be well prepared for class participation
- Cooperate with teachers and be supportive of class assignments or projects
- Be respectful of teacher authority.

Students

- Students are expected to complete course assignments on time and come fully prepared for class
- Students should come to class with appropriate materials (book, paper, pencil, etc.)
- If students does not complete scheduled work and turn assignments in on time, a detention will be assigned
- If a student is tardy to a class 2 times in one semester, a detention will be assigned
- A student absent from 4 classes in one semester may be asked to drop the class

About Detention

- Detention is for 1 hour and is to be served on the same day it was assigned, beginning at 3:00
- Any student required to serve detention will be expected to help the parent volunteers who are cleaning. There may be other specific jobs assigned to a student in detention
- If a detention is not served as required, additional detention time will be added. If necessary, a meeting with the Principal, teacher, parent, and student will be arranged
- If a student receives 3 detentions in one semester for the same class, a meeting of the Principal, teacher, parent, and the student will be held to seek a solution. The student may be asked not to return to that class and/or expulsion (at the discretion of leadership).
